

James Patrick (Jamie) Baldwin is a lecturer, author, and consultant in air transportation and is the Principal, JPB TRANS CONSULTING, LLC. He teaches Business Law, Contracts, and Torts as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Maryland Global Campus and is a Visiting Lecturer on Air Transport at the University of Westminster, London, United Kingdom and on Airline Operations at Emirates Aviation University.
